BROKERAGE AGREEMENT

This agreement between the undersigned and Revolvo West, LLC constitutes the terms of financial arrangements for Revolvo West to purchase vehicle(s) at auction. Revolvo West is licensed as an automotive dealer in the State of Oregon under the certified number 7885 and maintains all bond and insurance requirements to function as such. Our current license is valid through April 30, 2013

Revolvo West's standard auction arrangements are as follows:

- 1) We purchase the agreed upon vehicle(s) and charge a flat fee of \$1,500.00 after all necessary expenses related to the purchase of the vehicle(s).
- 2) The advance fee of \$1,500.00 represents earnest money for Revolvo West to perform its contractual responsibilities to its customer(s).
- 3) The balance of the cost of the vehicle(s) is due and payable within five working days of the purchase/auction date.

A typical brokerage deal would look like this:

The customer requests a loaded early 2000's Volvo S60 sedan, which retails around \$29,000 and wholesales around \$25,000. We drive or fly to the auction city, which typically costs about the same due to the expense of standard mileage costs and those of staying at motels when driving, totaling somewhere between \$300-\$500. In this example, Revolvo West made a dedicated trip to the monthly Volvo Finance Lease Return sale to obtain the best, low mileage Volvo S60 within the customer's financial parameters. On this trip, we were able to purchase a 2005 Volvo with only 13,000 miles for an incredibly good price! The trip and related expenses added approximately \$400 to the expense of the vehicle. The bid price Revolvo West agreed to pay the auction was \$20,500 with a buy fee of \$360.

Depending upon which auction we attend, our fiscal arrangement with the auctions allows us to sign for the vehicle and remove it from the auction before they receive the funds. Had we simply signed papers at the auction for the vehicle expenses, the privilege of leaving on just a promissory note, would have cost us a draft fee by both the auction and our bank—approximately \$150. This amount covers their administrative responsibilities of assembling the transfer papers and sending the necessary titling documents to our bank. The bank charges us a set fee of \$20 for transacting the title.

In this case, the new owner sent a wire transfer directly to the auction and we arranged vehicle transport for \$300 and the auction charged \$30 to deliver the title to Revolvo West via FedEx. The final expenses come in the form of DMV fees. For this car, with out-of-state title and registration, the fees amounted to \$171. The total cost of the vehicle before our standard fee came to \$22,200; still more than \$7,000 below retail value. Obviously, vehicles are negotiated and purchased on a specific individual basis. These customers were extremely pleased with their new vehicle and their sizable savings.

As you can see, much goes into the purchase of a quality vehicle. We at Revolve West would like to thank you in advance for this opportunity to serve your automotive needs. When we receive your financial commitment we will immediately return a receipt to you.
